### When and Where:

- Apply fresh coat of paint to markers that are in need
- Reposition markers that are leaning or have fallen
- Be respectful of any markers that have been personalized by loved ones of fallen soldiers

### What To Bring:

- Wear old clothes and shoes that you don't mind getting paint or mud on
- Boots or shoes with tread that will grip the steep hillside (it can be slippery)
- Work gloves (if you have them)
- Small garden trowel and mallet for setting markers (if you have them; also label your tools with your name)
- Water and a snack

Paint, brushes and other tools will be available at the site
