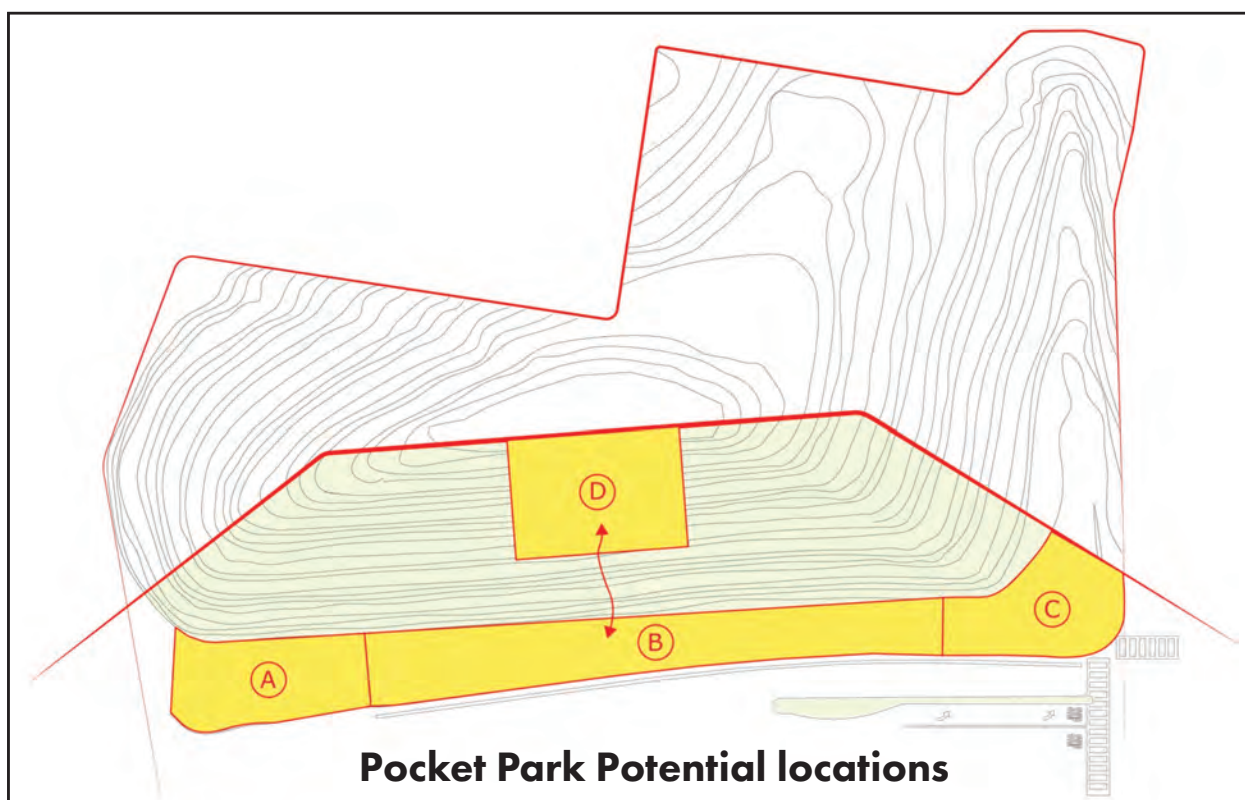

A Pocket Park

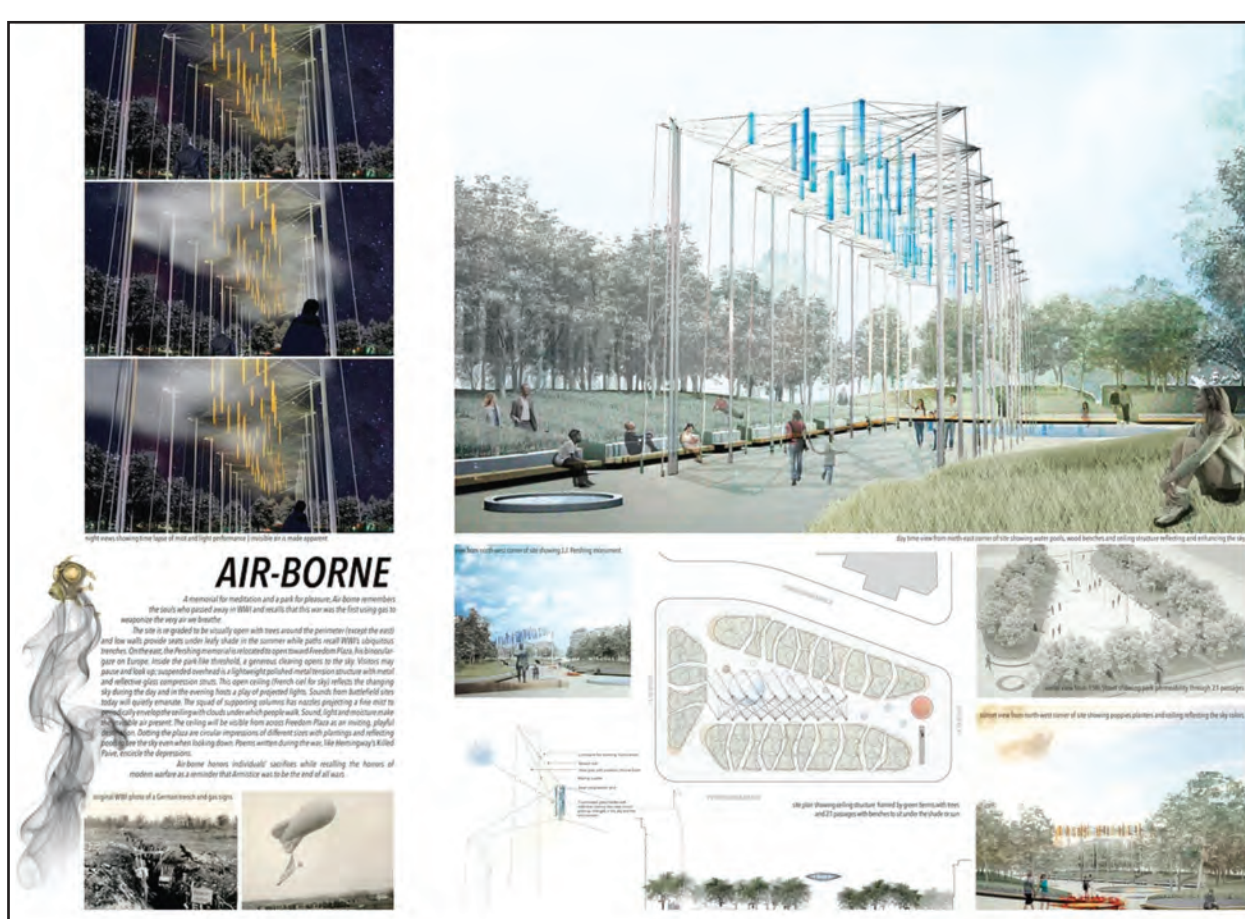
Create a pocket park. Park should be self sustaining and might be as simple as a small garden and seating area with interpretive signage about the history of the site.



A New Public Art Component

Exemplified here is the concept of a Peace Pole visible from hwy 24 and BART to be set within a meditation garden with interpretive signage

Host a Competition



A Paid Invited Competition or Open Call for Entries

Above is an example of a competition entry for the Plaza to the Forgotten War in Washington DC. (Johnsen Schmalting Architects, Milwaukee, WI) The five finalists moved on to phase two, a process which entailed public viewing and commentary in selecting a winner.

Commission an Artist



Publish a Public Request for Proposals or Qualifications

The Oakland Firestorm Memorial Sculpture was commissioned to remember the 25 lives lost in the 1991 Firestorm. Gail Fredell, a local artist and architect was selected through a public RFQ and the artwork was designed within parameters provided by the community.
